

Section 1: General Terms and Conditions

1. 1. Making a Booking

All bookings are made with ASCZ. No contract exists until ASCZ has received signed General Terms and Conditions and Child Info Form and a corresponding deposit. The person signing the General Terms and Conditions declares that he/she has the authority of the party member (and when party member is under 18, the authority of a parent or legal guardian) to contract ASCZ on behalf of said party member on the basis of these conditions and have agreed to be bound by them. No additions, deletions, or adjustments may be made to these conditions apart from in writing by the ASCZ director.

2. Payments, Cancellation and Refund Policy

Full payment to camp, including extra services, must be received 10 days prior to the start of camp. ASCZ reserves the right to cancel the reservation, without refund of deposit, if this condition is not met. Cancellation of a reservation and any reduction in the number of participants or the period of stay must be communicated to ASCZ in writing. For Summer 2020 only, under the circumstances surrounding travel in these uncertain times, we have a new cancellation policy that allows for FREE cancellation up to 24h before arrival.

3. Events beyond ASCZ's control

No reimbursements will be made for late arrivals or early departures. Natural disasters, closing of airports, technical problems, threat of war, transportation accidents, fire, bad weather or any other events beyond the control of ASCZ that may affect the running of the programme, will not be the responsibility of ASCZ. If ASCZ decides that the camp cannot be run, we will refund the total amount of money received. If the participant decides on his/her own not to attend, even though it will normally run, that participant cannot claim any refund.

4. Liability

It is not possible for ASCZ to be responsible for any service not directly under our control, such as, but not limited to, ski lifts, airlines and world events. Accordingly, ASCZ will not be responsible for any additional expenses, distress, disappointment, loss, damage, injury, accident, delay, inconvenience or irregularity resulting from the act of any other company, firm or persons, unless caused by either the proven negligence or lack of diligence by ASCZ. Any claims with respect to such matters must be made against the appropriate principal.

5. Parent's Responsibilities

Parents/guardians accept full financial responsibility for anyone they register in ASCZ for the following reasons:

- i. Damage caused, willful or not, to facilities, equipment, clothing or anything else belonging to or leased to ASCZ.
- ii. Repatriation costs for any child having to be sent home due to illness, accident, misbehavior, or any other reason deemed necessary by ASCZ.
- iii. Any pocket money or any purchase of items of a personal nature made on behalf of the child for anything not expressly included in the camp package.
- iv. Rental of any equipment deemed by ASCZ essential for a child to enjoy camp due to his/her own equipment being unsuitable, unsafe or missing.

6. Children's Behaviour

Children, whilst under constant supervision of ASCZ staff, are expected to adhere to all ASCZ's rules and regulations. ASCZ reserves the right to request a child is sent home if the child is deemed negligent of said rules and regulations. In this case, all additional travel costs incurred are the responsibility of the parent and there will be no refund of camp fees given.

7. Adverse Weather Conditions

ASCZ cannot be held responsible for adverse weather conditions that negatively affect the campers' ability to participate in activities. If ASCZ considers weather conditions to be hazardous, activities may be curtailed or cancelled. If activities are cancelled, we will endeavour to find alternative suitable activities.

8. 3rd Party Liability Insurance

ASCZ has a 3rd Party Liability Policy with Zurich Insurance. This provides indemnity in respect of legal liability to pay compensation for accidental injury to 3rd parties or accident loss or damage to their property.

9. Promotional Materials

ASCZ reserves the right to use any photographs or work by participants on its website and publications.

10. Medical Treatment

ASCZ shall have full authority to take whatever action it deems necessary to safeguard the health and well being of the child. This includes medical treatment for the child at the expense of the parent/guardian.

11. Cancellation or modification of programmes

ASCZ reserves the right to cancel or change any programmes because of insufficient number of participants or any other reason beyond its control. If this rare event occurs an alternative camp programme or full refund will be offered.

Section 2 – Parents/Guardians Declaration

I have understood the above Booking Conditions. I can confirm that I know the children on this field trip will participate in sports activities with inherent risks during the course of their camp. The sports in particular are, but not restricted to, football, volleyball, basketball, tennis, bowling, climbing, hiking, biking, go-karting, kick bikes, dirt scooters and walking.

In my role as Field Trip Leader, I accept these risks. I also confirm that I understand that these activities take place under the responsibility of ASCZ staff and also 3rd persons or companies carefully chosen and contracted by ASCZ. I understand that security measures specific to each activity, the qualifications of the staff, guide or other persons are discerned choices and that the measures are suitable and sufficient.
